




#### 2024/2025 OUTLOOK





AFAC has not highlighted any increased risk of fire this spring in NSW.




The Australian Flammability Monitoring System gives you a real time view of the potential for the country to burn: <u>http://wenfo.org/afms/</u>



### FIRE HISTORY



- All recent fires have come from the West
- In 1976 and 2001 there were Northerly and Easterly threats
- In 2019/20 if the Southerly had arrived a little later, we would have had to cope with a fire from the South






#### How we Protect Kurrajong Heights



- We use mosaic-based hazard reduction burning to ensure that any approaching fire will have to cross a recently burnt part of the mosaic
- This was the status before Gospers Mountain Fire in 2019
- Much of the area to the West and SW of the Heights as far as the Grose River was then burnt on 21.12.2019 in a successful backburn





### LINES OF DEFENSE



- Mountain Lagoon Road from Bilpin to Mountain Lagoon
- Bilpin to Donna's Track and then down into the Grose River
  - If this had not been successfully defended in 2019/2020 Bowen Mountain would have been threatened





## The National Park



- The dark areas show where the 2019 fires destroyed the canopy
- The sun has been able to penetrate and with huge volumes of rain we have seen unprecedented growth








### What Sustains a Fire?



- The fire triangle shows fire requires all three elements to be sustained:
  - Oxygen
  - Heat
  - Fuel
- We can only control the fuel





## Your Fire Plan

- You need to complete it as a family
- The BIG decision is whether to stay or go
  - It's best to prepare your place to stay .. as a fast-moving fire can mean its 'too late to leave'





## STAY OR GO?



#### DON'T LEAVE TOO LATE

- Up to one third of all bushfire deaths are caused by late leavers
- We only have BLOR. It can easily get blocked & Police may prevent access
- If you are not certain of having a clear evacuation route you should stay

#### DON'T BE AFRAID TO STAY

- Your house structure can protect you as the fire passes
- If you are well prepared, you can make the difference between the house surviving as well
- Many houses catch alight long after the fire has passed



- Prepare your home

- Plant Fire retardant plants
- Make sure we can get a tanker up your drive
- Invest in a fire pump & fit sprinklers to your house
- Get a generator
  - And then your electric water pumps will still work







#### LAGOON CREEK









